







Kirby Supply List for 7-12 English Classes

I am preparing to teach my classes outside as long as the weather permits. Some of my classes will be taught in the library and some of them will be taught in the English classroom. The English classroom has one window, with little airflow, so I feel most comfortable teaching outside. I think several teachers are planning to teach outside, so these supplies can be used throughout the day. Therefore, to make outside learning more comfortable and effective, I am asking parents to send with their child the follow: (I am including images for reference only. Feel free to select items different from the ones portrayed in this list)

<p>Camp Chair</p>		<p>Students will benefit from sitting upright and out of the grass/dirt, especially as the weather changes for fall</p>
<p>Portable lap desk</p>		<p>Portable lap desks give students a hard surface to use their chromebooks. It will also be easier to hold large textbooks and write in notebooks. A desk with cellphone holder is not necessary :0).</p>

<p>Two 1-subject Notebooks. College Ruled 8" x 10.5"</p>		<p>Normally, I ask students to purchase composition notebooks, but with outside learning this year, it will be easier with spiral notebooks that allow students to lay their notebook flat.</p>
<p>Post-it or Sticky Notes of varying sizes.</p>		<p>Sticky Notes allow students to read school-owned books/textbooks and take notes they can refer back to.</p>
<p>Pens.</p>		<p>Pens are simpler than pencils. If you get pencils, it will also be important for you to get a couple of large erasers and pencil sharpeners</p>
<p>Pen/pencil case</p>		<p>Something like this would be really helpful as students are moving about. A small backpack would work, too.</p>
