

## Fifth/Sixth Grade Math and Science Supply List

Dear Fifth/Sixth Graders,

Welcome back! Here are the supplies you will need for the upcoming year in math and science.

### Important Supplies:

- **Pencils** (Lots of them! At least 40!)
  - Plain, yellow #2 pencils are just fine!
  - Mechanical pencils are great, but don't forget lead
  - Leave a supply of pencils at home for homework
- **Pens** (preferably not black)
- **Desire to learn**
- **Loose-leaf Notebook Paper**
  - Wide-rule
  - 200 sheets
- **2 Binders**
  - 3 ring
  - 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  or 2 inch
- **2-pocket Folder**
  - Blue
- **Glue Stick** - (20 white, not purple)
- **Erasers** -(for top of a pencil and/or handheld)
- **Patience**
- **Pencil Bag or Pouch**
- **Sense of humor**
- **P.E. Shoes**
- **Deodorant**
- **Disinfecting Wipes** - (large pack or container)
- **Determination**
- **Earbuds or Headphones**
- **Wireless computer mouse for Chromebook** - (optional)
- **Grit**

### Things we can share:

- Plain or decorative duct tape
- Colored pencils
- Sharpies - ultrafine point black and fine point black/colors
- Washable markers

- 20 oz or 2 L Plastic Bottles - Rinsed and Dried
- Plastic forks, spoons, and knives
- Plastic gallon zipper bags
- Plastic zipper sandwich bags
- Plastic zipper snack bags
- Any color film canisters (if you have them)

**Please DON'T Bring:**

- Staplers
- Calculators
- Scented Lotion, Body Spray, or Perfume
- Rulers

**\*Helpful hint:** Most fifth/sixth graders run out of supplies like pencils and paper at school. Remember to replenish supplies periodically throughout the school year.
